Decisions and Guidelines

In the third semester of the Master Programme in Business and Management, students get the opportunity to acquire working life experience, as an integrated part of their programme. The internship course is an opportunity to experiencing practical work in an organization outside of the university and applying theoretical knowledge. The course syllabus was approved by the board of the Department of Business Studies on delegation from the Faculty of Social Sciences and takes effects as of 2010-.

Aims

The aim of the internship is that the student

- use acquired theoretical knowledge and skills from the programme in business and management in real practice situations
- work independently as well as in teams with others
- develop an understanding for the role of his/her education in their professional life
- get the opportunity to build a professional network
- get inspiration for his/her Master thesis.

Learning outcomes

At the end of the course, the student

- understands how theoretical knowledge can be used in practice situations
- has developed skills for working independently outside of the university context
- has developed skills for working in teams with professionals
- is better prepared for their professional career

Instructions

There are no structured activities for this course. The student's activities are agreed upon in cooperation between the department and the internship organization.

Examination

Performance in the course will be evaluated by representatives at the Department of Business Studies on basis of the student's activities during internship. Swedish grades G and U are supplemented by pass/not passed.

Only completed courses can be recognized in your degree.
